**AUTHORITY** The event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the Speed Events Standing Regulations, Victorian Hillclimb Championship Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations or instructions which may be issued, and shall be subject to CAMS PERMIT NUMBER 319/2804/04

**THE EVENT** will be a State Championship Hillclimb and **ROUND 4** of the **2019 TRYDEL VICTORIAN HILLCLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP** to be conducted at Bryant Park, Bill Schulz Drive, Yallourn on Sunday April 28, 2019

**ENTRIES:** will open on the **publication of these Regulations** and will close at **5.00 p.m. on Tuesday the 23<sup>rd</sup> of April, 2019.** (NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED)

Entry fees for the Multiclub Hillclimb will be **\$120 (Junior Drivers \$60).** All entry fees include GST.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au). The Promoters reserve the right to stipulate the number of entries for the Meeting, and select entries in excess of such number at their absolute discretion. The maximum number of entries may be 140, accepted in order of receipt. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

**COMPETITION** Official runs will commence at 10.00 AM. on Sunday April 28, 2019 – the number of official runs will be notified at the Driver's Briefing.

**PERSONS ELIGIBLE** The event shall be open to members of clubs affiliated with CAMS who are holders of a CAMS Level 2S/2SJ or higher Licence.

**SCRUTINY** Scrutiny will commence at 8.00 a.m. and conclude at 11.30 am. on Sunday April 28 2019. All cars must be scrutineered and passed for competition prior to the commencement of competition. CAMS Licences, Competition Records and current Club membership cards must be produced at Scrutiny, and on request during the Meeting. **All vehicles competing in the 2019 Trydel Victorian Hillclimb Championship must have a CAMS Log Book**, which must be presented at Scrutiny. Entries will be accepted from competitors/vehicles without a CAMS Log Book, but these entries will only be accepted after all Log Booked entries have been accepted. Such Competitors will not score points in the 2019 Trydel Victorian Hillclimb Championship.

**DRIVERS BRIEFING** The attendance of all Drivers is required at a Drivers Briefing to be held at 9.30am. on Sunday April 29, 2019. Drivers who fail to attend such briefings may be liable for a penalty imposed by the Stewards. The starting order and starting procedures will be advised at the Drivers Briefing. Any changes to the running order during the Event are at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

**TIMING** will be electronic, and be to one hundredth of a second. Event winners will be those Drivers with the fastest time for a single run in each class. In the event of a tie, the next fastest official time of each Driver will determine the event winner. Timekeepers will be considered Judges of Fact.

**PROTESTS** Any protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current NCR.

**ABANDONMENT** The Promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual. The meeting will be postponed to a date to be determined if a **TOTAL FIRE BAN** has been declared for the **WEST AND SOUTH GIPPSLAND FIRE DISTRICT** for the day of the event. In the case of this event, if Sunday 28 April 2019 is a day of total fire ban, the Meeting will be postponed to a date to be determined.

**SAFETY - DRIVER** Drivers must wear a helmet to a standard listed in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and be deemed by the Scrutineers of the Event to be in a suitable condition for motorsport use, non flammable clothing, suitable footwear, and goggles or visors with lens other than glass in open car. All apparel, including helmets, must comply with the requirements of Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual.

**SAFETY - CARS** The attention of Competitors is drawn to Schedules A and B of the General Requirements for Cars and Drivers of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport in which all vehicle requirements are listed in detail. In particular, fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual and all vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

**ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES.** Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMA Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

- 12.VHC-Improved Production-2WD-3001cc and over
- 13.VHC-Improved Production-2WD-up to1600cc
- 14.VHC-Improved Production- 4WD-3001cc and over
- 15.VHC-Improved Production -4WD-up to 3000cc
- 16.VHC-Non Log Booked Cars (non-championship points scoring cars)
- 17.VHC-Prod Sports 2B & 2F- 2001cc up to 3000cc
- 18.VHC-Prod Sports 2B & 2F- 3001cc and over
- 19.VHC-Prod Sports 2B & 2F- up to 2000cc
- 20.VHC-Sports Cars- 2WD- Clubman up to 1600cc
- 21.VHC-Sports Cars- 2WD- Open/Closed 2001cc to 3000cc

- 23.VHC-Sports Cars- 2WD- Open/Closed up to 2000cc
- 24.VHC-Sports Cars- 4WD- (all capacities)
- 25.VHC-Sports Sedans- 2WD-up to 1600cc
- 26.VHC-Sports Sedans- 2WD-1601cc to 2000cc
- 27.VHC-Sports Sedans- 2WD-2001cc and over
- 28.VHC-Sports Sedans- 4WD- up to 3000cc
- 29.VHC-Sports Sedans- 4WD 3001cc and over
- 30.VHC- Supersports

Classes may, at the Promoters discretion, be combined where there are less than three entries in a class. Where there are sufficient entries, further classes may be created (e.g. Formula Libre up to 750cc, etc.). Competitors in Historic – Other must provide a Certificate of Description for their vehicle.

**AWARDS** Trophies will be awarded to the person achieving fastest time of day, to those finishing second and third outright, and to the first, second and third fastest time in each class. Further awards may be made, and these will be notified to Competitors in any further information that may be forwarded to Competitors and/or at the Drivers Briefing.

**TRACK CONFIGURATION** This Event will be conducted on the **Clockwise Paper Clip Track** configuration, over a distance of approximately 1600 metres.

**COMPETING CARS** Competing cars must be kept in the paddock area during the running of the meeting. Competitors trailers must be parked in the trailer park or other designated areas, and must not be parked in spectator areas. All Drivers should enter the Circuit by the gate marked Competitors.

**REFUELLING** Refuelling must be carried out on either a concrete or grassed area – **REFUELLING IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE ASPHALT PIT AREAS.**

**ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES** Notification of the acceptance of entry will be forwarded to all competitors.

**GARAGES** A number of garages will be available for hire for the Event. These will be allocated on a first come basis. The cost of the garage hire is \$50. To arrange a garage, please contact David Bellenger on 0429 015 566. (**Do not include the garage hire with your entry**).

**PRACTICE** The track will be available for FREE untimed practice on Saturday April 28 2019 from 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.. The track gate will open at 8.00 a.m. on Sunday April 28, 2019.
